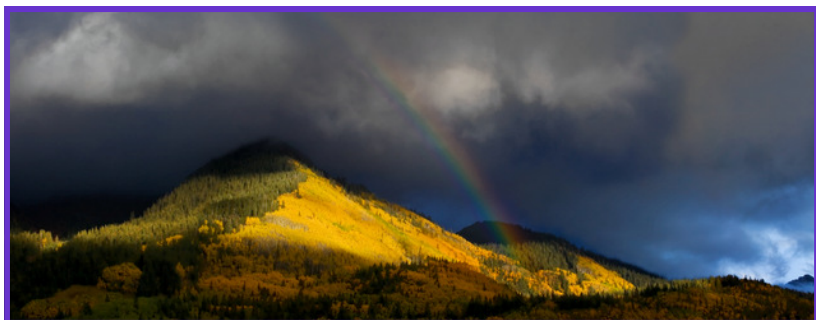

### Canon and Murphy's Sponsor Free Photo Event

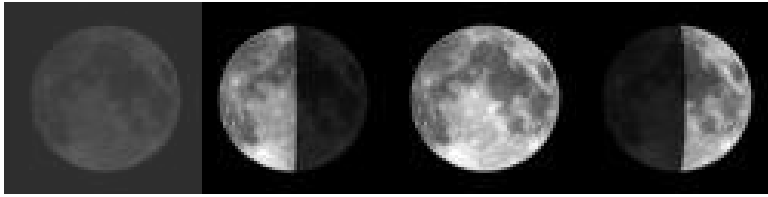
